

Schmitty Cake

1 box lemon cake mix*
3 c. diced rhubarb
1 c. superfine sugar
2 c. very vanilla soy milk

Spray a 9 x 13 pan with cooking spray and preheat oven to 350 degrees F.

In a large bowl, prepare cake mix according to package instructions then pour into 9 x 13 pan. Sprinkle top of cake batter with rhubarb, then sprinkle sugar over the top. Pour soy milk over whole cake.

Bake for 50-60 minutes until done. Place in refrigerator to cool.

Cut into squares and flip upside down on plate to serve.

Notes

- *I read a lot of cake mix package labels before I found one that did not contain dairy. As ingredient lists often change, it's important to check it each time. When I made this recipe, I used Duncan Hines Moist Deluxe Lemon Cake Mix and it did not contain dairy.
- Most cake mix recipes call for vegetable oil and eggs, so be sure to check the package ingredient list and have those on hand as well.
- If you're using frozen rhubarb, be sure to thaw and drain it well before adding to cake.
- This cake gets better with time, reaching a good peak on day two, if it lasts that long.
